## WHAT TO EXPECT

- As an external apprentice, you will have approximately 26 educator sessions throughout the duration of your apprenticeship. These sessions will be every 2 weeks face to face at your place of work, unless stated differently.
- As an internal apprentice attending one of our academies, you will have approximately 52 sessions in total that will take place weekly at one of our academies.
- Our educators have many years of hands on experience within the industry giving them the knowledge to support you
  every step of the way. Educator sessions are there to discuss your progress, assign you tasks and prepare you for
  your apprenticeship assessment.

# **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Individual employers may set their own entry requirements. The apprentice must already be employed for over 16 hours per week.

- If a candidate is 16-18 they must have achieved maths and English at Level 2 prior to completion of the course, this is something that can be completed with us if needed.
- If a candidate is 19+ and hasn't achieved in Maths and English GCSE before enrolling, it is up to the employer to decide whether these qualifications should be attempted.
- The candidate must be employed in a suitable role.

Apply precision cutting, personalised sectioning, and advanced styling techniques to deliver bespoke and creative hairstyles.

#### **Advanced Colour & Correction**


Perform advanced colour conversions and corrections, including removal of artificial colour, highlights/lowlights adjustments, and re-colouring, using thorough consultations and tests.

#### **Hair Health & Treatments**

Analyse hair and scalp condition, apply treatments to strengthen and smooth hair, resolve issues, and evaluate results to ensure quality outcomes.

#### **Professional Skills & Behaviours**

Demonstrate creativity, individual flair, flexibility, problem-solving, safe working practices, and commitment to professional growth and continuous development.



# APPRENTICESHIP ASSESSMENT

The Apprenticeship Assessment includes:

- · A 40 question knowledge test
- A practical assessment and questioning lasting 5 hours. This will involve the following:
  - The learner must complete a precision cut and finish from their personal collection of hairstyle looks, chosen by the client.
  - The learner must complete an advanced creative colour conversion on previously coloured
  - Questioning will follow each of the services for a total of four questions.
- Professional discussion supported by a portfolio of evidence (45 minutes).
- For the practical assessment learners will be required to sources their own models.
